Requirements:

- The topic and main contents of your workshop should be clearly stated

How to apply:

Send us an email at peace@tvind.dk telling us about your experience in this type of events or delivering workshops, and your activity workshop or presentation proposal in detail. You can include links to any of your previous work.

Indicate clearly the time frame for your activity/ speech/ workshop, number of participants, any materials that you might need eg projector/ whiteboard/ speakers/ microphone and the kind of space that you require to carry out your proposal.

Don't be afraid to think outside the box, and be creative with your application.

Selection process:

All applicants will be assessed:

- Solely on the information provided within the application
- Objectively, based on the requirements of the project outlined in this brief
- By the selection panel, made up of representatives of DNS teacher council and student body and, where appropriate, representatives of partner organisations.
